1. What is Kintsugi?

- -Learn about the history and sustainability of kintsugi with urushi, the sap of trees.

 Our workshop stays true to tradition,
- unlike modern methods using synthetic adhesives.
- -Enjoy discovering the various kintsugi works.

2. Kintsugi Demonstration

- -Bond the broken pieces of vessels together, with 'mugi urushi,' a natural adhesive made by kneading flour and mixing it with lacquer.
- -Coat with lacquer and sprinkle with gold (brass) powder.

3.Let's try Kintsugi!

- -Paint lacquer to the dish. It can be a little tricky to apply the lacquer in fine lines and small areas, but don't worry, you can definitely do it!
- -Sprinkle brass/tin powder on the lacquer which you painted.
